

**ILLUSTRATORS VISIT
PAUL O. ZELINSKY'S ANGELS
TO OGRES EXHIBIT**

Several Chapter illustrators got together for another interesting outing. This time they went to the Irving Art Center to view a display of Paul O. Zelinsky's graphic art, which includes translations of classic children's stories, such as *Hansel and Gretel*, *Rumlestiltskin* and his 1998 Caldecott Medal-winning *Rapunzel*.

There were also displays of his movable books, i.e. children's books that have moving parts, and chapter books for older children, such as Beverly Cleary's *Dear Mr. Henshaw* and E. Nesbit's *Five Children and It*. Witty characters steal the show in his off-beat adaptations of poems and stories in rhyme, such as *The Maid and the Mouse* and *the Odd-shaped House*.
